Our Priorities

To use allocated Participatory Budget (PB) in consultation with all stakeholders

To reduce the Cost of the School Day (COSD) for all families, raising awareness of supports available

To use targeted interventions to raise attainment in Literacy and Numeracy

To further develop effective differentiation in class, to enable effective challenge and support.

To promote positive wellbeing, relationships and self-esteem through nurture opportunities.

To increase engagement and leadership opportunities for targeted learners

What will we do?

Develop a pupil group to lead and inform the wider school community of Cost of the School Day. Allocate PB in consultation with all stakeholders. Share and celebrate our use of the PB with all stakeholders, including impact.

Further deepen understanding of the impact of the COSD. Promote supports for COSD with pupils, parents and staff consistently. Consult all stakeholders on newly created school equity strategy paper, which highlights rationale and approaches to reduce the COSD.

SfL and PSW intervention groups to support Literacy and Numeracy with targeted learners. Collaboration with the Language and Literacy Support Service to further build staff capacity. Effective assessment in Literacy and Numeracy to identify next steps.

Staff participation in the WLC Leaders of Learning programme. Support for Learning (SfL) input, including in-class team teaching, planning support, and advice on inclusive practices, including the use of digital tools.

Implement nurture groups that provide a safe and supportive environment where pupils can build confidence and develop positive relationships, through engagement with wider experiences and opportunities.

Identified learners continued participation in the 'Young Leaders of Learning' programme, leading training of new pupil members. Observe, evaluate and give feedback to support school improvement and provide authentic pupil voice.
